GOMHS Uniform Policy

- All students will be expected to follow the dress code policy as stated in the East Baton Rouge Parish Rights & Responsibilities Handbook.
- Uniform vendors will be present.
- Students are only allowed to wear pants.
- **Uniform pants must be khaki and cannot be cargos, joggers, or jeggings.**
- **(High School Students)**
 - **All 9th grade** students are required to wear **red** uniform shirts.
 - **All other grades may wear either black, gray, or white uniform shirts.**
- Middle students will wear **navy blue shirts with no logos.**
- Students are only allowed to wear an official GOMHS sweatshirt or a solid colored black, red, white, or gray sweatshirt. Sweatshirts will be available for purchase during orientation
- Solid color sweatshirts/hoodies cannot have an insignia larger than two inches.

GOMHS School Fee

- Each student will be responsible for a **\$20 school fee**. The school fee will cover the cost of two IDs.
- IDs **MUST** be worn every day. After the second ID has been issued, any other ID will need to be purchased at a cost of \$5 each.

Cell Phone Usage

- High school students may carry their cell phones; however, it must not be visible, in operation, or go off during the school day.
- Middle school students cannot have cell phones on campus.
- Headphones and taking/sending pictures or videos are **NOT** allowed and this practice is subject to disciplinary action.
- We ask for your support in helping us enforce this policy with our students.
